MULTI-STOREY CAR PARK

The Hines Meadow Multi-Storey Car Park was opened in April 1992. The 5 storey building provides parking facilities for 711 vehicles. Each floor steps back on the main frontage from the one below to reduce and soften the scale of this large building.

The materials used are in character with the locality, such as brickwork, stone cappings and pitched roofs, which help the building blend in with the local urban scale. The use of extensive landscaping further enhances the facade treatment with inbuilt planter boxes in front of the pitching mansards.

Each of the 4 stair cores is colour coded internally, using anti-vandal paint, with each floor colour coded to ease identification of floors to the public. The whole internal effect is bright and airy to make people feel safe in their car parking environment.

The building provides Maidenhead with an attractive landmark and gives the town centre a much needed additional car parking facility. It has easy undercover access to the town centre and is linked to the popular Sainsbury supermarket and the Magnet Leisure Centre. The main access to the car park is off a slip road on the A4 trunk road and the exit is via Crown Lane to the rear of the site. At night the car park is dramatically displayed from the A4 trunk road by the floodlighting of the stepped facade.
